GOSPEL: When Judas had gone Jesus said:

"Now has the Son of Man been glorified, and in Him God has been glorified. If God has been glorified in Him, God will in turn glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him very soon. My little children I will not be with you much longer. I give you a new commandment: love one another; just as I have loved you, you must also love one another. By this love you have for one another, everyone will know that you are My disciples."

- ◆ How will people know that you are a disciple of Jesus?
- ◆ In what ways do you glorify God?
- ◆ How do you show love for others?

DID YOU KNOW?

- ◆ The title "Son of Man" is often used by Jesus in the Gospels to describe Himself.
- ◆ In the Gospel of John, when Jesus speaks of being glorified or exalted, He is referring to His death on the cross. For John, this is the moment of supreme triumph for Jesus.
- ◆ This text comes from a section of John's Gospel known as the Farewell Discourse which is delivered by Jesus to His friends just before His arrest. Here, Judas has already gone out to betray Him.

SYMBOLS & IMAGES

The new commandment of love for one another becomes the defining principle and sign of discipleship. It is through this love for each other, which sets believers apart from the rest of the community, that people will know they are followers of Jesus. This is much more difficult than it sounds! The biggest challenge is to act with love towards those we find it difficult to like!

MARY'S SPIRITUAL MOTHERHOOD

Jesus, dying on the cross, said to John, "There is your mother." From that moment, and from when "the disciple took her into his care, "the mystery of **Mary's Spiritual Motherhood** has had its accomplishment in history with boundless amplitude. Motherhood means concern for the life of the child. Now, if Mary is the mother of all mankind, then her concern for the life of man has **universal extension**. A mother's concern embraces the whole man. Mary's maternity has its beginning in her maternal care for Christ. In Christ, she accepted John beneath the cross, and, in him, **she accepted every human and all humanity**. Mary embraces all with a particular solicitude in the Holy Spirit. In fact, as we profess in our Creed, it is He who "gives life ..."

Mary's spiritual motherhood is therefore **participation in the power of the Holy Spirit**, of Him who "gives life." It is likewise the humble handmaid of her who says of herself: "I am the servant of the Lord."

In the light of the mystery of the spiritual maternity of Mary, let us try to understand the extraordinary message which began to resound in the world from Fatima on May 13th, 1917.
