PSALM RESPONSE: O God, let all the nations praise You!

GOSPEL ACCL: Alleluia, alleluia!
All who love Me will keep My words,
And My Father will love them, and we will come to them.
Alleluia!

GOSPEL: Jesus said to His disciples: 'If anyone loves Me he will keep My word, and my Father will love him, and We shall come to him and make Our home with him. Those who do not love Me will not keep My words. And My word is not My own: it is the word of the One who sent me. I have said these things to you while still with you; but the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name, will teach you everything and remind you of all I have said to you. Peace I bequeath to you, My own peace I give you, a peace the world cannot give, this is My gift to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid. You heard Me say: I am going away, and shall return. If you loved Me you would have been glad to know that I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. I told you this now before it happens, so that when it does happen you may believe.'

DID YOU KNOW?

- The meaning of the word 'advocate' is one who is summoned to help another.
- Another term commonly used for the Holy Spirit is *Paraclete* which comes from a Greek term meaning 'called to the side of' and so has the same meaning as 'advocate'.
- In the Hebrew Scriptures, peace was one of the distinguishing marks of the time of the Messiah. Jesus' gift of peace confirms that He is the longed for Messiah.

To ensure we hear the voices of children and have the necessary skills to identify and respond appropriately, we invite any volunteers who have not yet participated in Child Safe Environments training or an equivalent course to attend a **90 MINUTE VOLUNTEER BRIEFING** session facilitated by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit. Please note that these briefings (or an equivalent course) are a compulsory requirement for anyone wishing to be a Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.

A Volunteer Briefing will be held in our Parish on:

Tuesday 20th August at 6.30pm in the Parish Hall.

Note: If you have attended a Child Safe Environments or RAN training within the past 3 years you do not need to attend a Volunteer Briefing.
