PSALM RESPONSE: O Lord our God,
how wonderful your name in all the earth!

GOSPEL ACCL: Alleluia, alleluia!
Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit:
to God Who is, Who was, and Who is to come.
Alleluia!

GOSPEL: Jesus said to his disciples: "I still have many things to say to you but they would be too much for you now. But when the Spirit of truth comes He will lead you to the complete truth, since He will not be speaking as from Himself but will only say what He has learnt; and He will tell you of the things to come. He will glorify Me, since all He tells you will be taken from what is Mine. Everything the Father has is Mine; that is why I said: All He tells you will be taken from what is Mine."

DID YOU KNOW?

- The early Christians struggled to understand the belief that God is both one and three. Many great Councils of the Church were held to clarify what this meant and to find the language with which to describe the Trinitarian relationship between Father, Son and Spirit. It was not until the Council of Constantinople in 381 AD that the doctrine of the Trinity was defined.
- Many of the prayers of the Church express our belief in a Triune God (three persons in one). One of the simplest and the most simple of these prayers is the Sign of the Cross in which we dedicate ourselves "in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit."
- St Augustine described the Trinity in terms of the Lover, the Beloved and the Love which exists between them.

SYMBOLS & IMAGES

Human beings will always struggle before the mystery of God who is One but also Three. Augustine's idea of the Trinity as a communion of love is a very rich and powerful image. Can our own communication of love with others teach us something of the life and love of the Trinity?

CHILD SAFE ENVIRONMENTS BRIEFING FOR VOLUNTEERS

As you may be aware, all volunteers in our Archdiocese are mandated notifiers under the South Australian Child Protection Legislation. To ensure we hear the voices of children and have the necessary skills to identify and respond appropriately, we invite any volunteers who have not yet participated in Child Safe Environments training or an equivalent course to attend a **90 MINUTE VOLUNTEER BRIEFING** session facilitated by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit. Please note that these briefings (or an equivalent course) are a **compulsory requirement for anyone wishing to be a Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.** *If you have attended a Child Safe Environments or RAN training within the past 3 years you do not need to attend a Volunteer Briefing.*
