## **FEAST OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST - YEAR C**

First Reading	Genesis 14:18-20	1 Kings 19:16, 19-21
Second Reading	1 Corinthians 11:23-26	Galatians 5:1, 13-18
Gospel	Luke 9:11-17	Luke 9:51-62

**PSALM RESPONSE:** You are a priest forever, in the line of Melchizedek.

**GOSPEL ACCL:** Alleluia, alleluia!  
I am the Living Bread from heaven, says the Lord;  
Whoever eats this Bread will live for ever.  
Alleluia!

**GOSPEL:** Jesus made the crowds welcome and talked to them about the kingdom of God; and He cured those who were in need of healing.

It was late in the afternoon when the twelve came to Him and said, 'Send the people away, and they can go to the villages and farms round about to find lodging and food; for we are in a lonely place here.' He replied, 'Give them something to eat yourselves.' But they said, 'We have no more than five loaves and two fish, unless we are to go ourselves and buy food for all these people.' For there were about five thousand men. But He said to His disciples, 'Get them to sit down in parties of about fifty.' They did so and made them all sit down. Then He took the five loaves and the two fish, raised His eyes to heaven, and said the blessing over them; then He broke them and handed them to the disciples to distribute among the crowd. They all ate as much as they wanted, and when the scraps remaining were collected they filled twelve baskets.

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

- The actions of our Eucharistic celebration are based on the actions of Jesus in this Gospel text and later at the Last Supper: the priest takes the bread, blesses it, breaks it and distributes to all who come to the table.
- The twelve baskets full of remaining food symbolises that the Eucharist can fill all our needs. The abundance of the Eucharist is more than enough to fill and sustain us
- The abundant feast is an image associated with the coming of the Messiah, the advent of God's Kingdom. In this gospel text, Jesus is bringing an experience of God's reign in the present time to those whom He fed in such abundance.

### **SYMBOLS & IMAGES**

'The lonely place' where this action occurs is a symbol of our own longing to be filled; our yearning to belong. Jesus welcomes all who come and He cures those in need of healing. For Catholics, the Eucharist satisfies all the needs of those who come to the table of the Lord. They are fed and nourished by the Body and Blood of Christ.

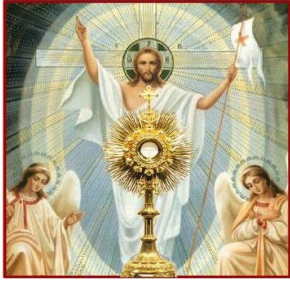

As you may be aware, all volunteers in our Archdiocese are mandated notifiers under the South Australian Child Protection Legislation. To ensure we hear the voices of children and have the necessary skills to identify and respond appropriately, we invite any volunteers who have not yet participated in Child Safe Environments training or an equivalent course to attend a **90 MINUTE VOLUNTEER BRIEFING** session facilitated by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit. Please note that these briefings (or an equivalent course) are a **compulsory requirement for anyone wishing to be a Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion**. *If you have attended a Child Safe Environments or RAN training within the past 3 years you do not need to attend a Volunteer Briefing.*
