**GOSPEL:** As the time drew near for Him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely took the road for Jerusalem and sent messengers ahead of Him. These set out and they went into a Samaritan village to make preparations for Him, but the people would not receive Him because He was making for Jerusalem. Seeing this, the disciples James and John said, 'Lord, do you want us to call down fire from heaven to burn them up?' But He turned and rebuked them, and they went off to another village.

As they travelled along they met a man on the road who said to Him, 'I will follow You wherever You go,' Jesus answered, 'Foxes have holes and the birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head.'

Another to whom He said, 'Follow Me,' replied 'Let me go and bury my father first.' But He answered, 'Leave the dead to bury their dead: your duty is to go and spread the news of the kingdom of God.'

Another said, 'I will follow You, sir, but first let me go and say goodbye to my people at home.' Jesus said to him, 'Once the hand is laid on the plough, no one who looks back is fit for the kingdom of God.'

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

- A key theme in Luke's writings is that of journey. In his Gospel, Jesus' journey to Jerusalem is the vehicle for preaching and for the formation of the disciples in what it means to be a follower of Christ.
- Luke's second volume is The Acts of the Apostles. In this book, the message of Jesus is taken by the Church outwards from Jerusalem to the ends of the earth.
- There existed an ancient rivalry between Samaritans and Jews, which caused each group to be suspicious of the other.

### **SYMBOLS & IMAGES**

What it means to be a disciple is at the heart of this text. Discipleship means sometimes undergoing discomfort and keeping oneself firmly focused on the real prize in life—the kingdom of God and eternal life with Him.

To ensure we hear the voices of children and have the necessary skills to identify and respond appropriately, we invite any volunteers who have not yet participated in Child Safe Environments training or an equivalent course to attend a **90 MINUTE VOLUNTEER BRIEFING** session facilitated by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit. Please note that these briefings (or an equivalent course) are a **compulsory requirement for anyone wishing to be a Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.** *If you have attended a Child Safe Environments or RAN training within the past 3 years you do not need to attend a Volunteer Briefing.*
