## Criteria for the Celebration of the Sacraments:

### *From Policy for the Initiation of Children into the Catholic Church*

*Sacramental initiation begins with Baptism and is completed with Confirmation and First Eucharist. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is an important part of preparing for Confirmation and First Eucharist for any baptized person who has the use of reason.*

- Children of the age of reason (usually 7 years old) who have an understanding of what becoming a Catholic involves are usually ready to receive the Sacraments.
- The celebration of the sacraments is not tied to any particular age or level of schooling. Children will celebrate the sacraments when they are ready to do so.
- Discernment of readiness is the joint responsibility of parents, teacher/catechist and Parish Priest.
